



UTILITY MERGER

A Citizens Guide

BACKGROUND

In 2006 the Town of Knightdale joined its water and sewer utility systems with Raleigh. The Towns of Garner, Rolesville, Wake Forest, Wendell, and Zebulon joined Knightdale in merging systems with the City of Raleigh. The merger allowed the Town to accomplish the following:

- Secure additional water and sewer capacity
- Expand the system's geographic service area
- Grow at a rate that otherwise would not have been possible
- Invest in community amenities like Knightdale Station Park, Mingo Creek Greenway, Knightdale Community Pool Improvements, and Knightdale Community Park
- Expand the employment and industrial base of the Town

The Town has completed its debt obligation to the City of Raleigh and has officially completed the merger.

"How does the merger affect me?" -

Knightdale residents will no longer pay a surcharge and will pay the same rates as the City of Raleigh Customers.

"Will my utility bill increase or decrease?" -

It depends, the City of Raleigh utilizes a tiered system. The Town can assist in estimating new bills if you provide information from your current bill. Call (919) 217-2200 for bill estimates or with questions.

"When will the new rates go into effect?" -

The merger will be complete and new rates will go into effect on July 1, 2018.
